Standard 6: Earth and the Solar System

The Earth is the third planet from the Sun in a system that includes the Moon, the Sun, eight other planets and their moons, and smaller objects, such as asteroids and comets. The student will engage in investigations that integrate the process standards and to the the discovery of the following objectives:

1. Most objects in the Solar System are in regular and predictable motion. Those motions explain such phenomena as the day, the year, phases of the Moon, and eclipses.
2. Seasons result from variations in the amount of the Sun's energy hitting the surface, due to the tilt of the Earth's rotation on its axis and the length of the day.
